NATIONAL CITY presents its first Downtown Dayton Fishing Tournament. The tournament has been organized by the East Dayton Optimist Club, Five Rivers MetroParks and the "Dumb Bassers" Club

**WHERE:** Great Miami River from the low dam at the old Tate Station (just east of Broadway Street), north to the area just east of Main Street where the Stillwater and Mad Rivers join the Great Miami.

**WHEN:** **September 7, 2008** from 12:00 Noon to 6:00 PM (rain or shine). (Sign in at tournament headquarters between 11:30 am and 12:00 noon before fishing begins.)

**FEES:** \$10.00 per person \$5.00 for youth under 16 years of age.

**Prizes:**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Largest Fish 35% of 1/2 of Entry Fees
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Largest Fish 20% of 1/2 of Entry Fees
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Largest Fish 10% of 1/2 of Entry Fees
- 1<sup>st</sup> Largest Game fish 20% of 1/2 of Entry Fees
- Largest fish caught by youth 15% of 1/2 of Entry Fees (under the age of 16)

**Limitations**

- Live/Artificial bait permitted
- No boats
- Must meet State of Ohio Laws
- Check in by 12:00 noon 9-7-08
- Pick up a participant card

Monument Ave.(on Monument just West of Patterson Blvd) **FREE PARKING IS AVAILABLE BEHIND Wright State Univ Bldg at the SW corner of St. Clair and Monument. Enter Parking Lot from St. Clair. Monument will be blocked between 11:30am and 12:30pm and again from 5:30pm to 6:30pm for easy pedestrian access to RiverScape MetroPark Tourney Hdqs.**

**Weigh in:** Begins at 5:45 p.m. All fish must be weighed alive.This is an environmental tournament, for every bag of trash brought to the scales four oz. will be added to the fish weighed in by that angler. Up to 4 bags for an additional 16 oz. will be accepted per angler. Prizes will be awarded between 6:00-6:15 PM. **DONATED PRIZES WILL BE GIVEN AWAY DURING WEIGH-IN.(YOU MUST BE PRESENT TO WIN)**

**How do you enter:** Cut off and complete the attached registration form and enclose same with your check or money order made out to "The All Ohio Police Fishing Tournament". If you opt to pay on the morning of the tournament, there will be an additional \$2.00 fee per person and only cash can be accepted, so we would greatly appreciate registration by mail in advance.
